DYNAMICS OF FAITH



> DEFINITION:

Dynamics comes from the Greek word 'dunamis', which means 'dynamite' explosion or power generator.

Faith: It is believing that what God has said He will do. Heb. 11:8

It is a spiritual gift from the Holy Spirit that a believer can possess and overcome the world. (1 John 5: 4)

It is takable, it is handlable. (Eph. 6: 16)

>> DIFFERENT VERSIONS OF THE BIBLE: HEBREWS 11:1:

1. KJV – Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen
2. Am. S. V. – Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen
3. N. I. V. – Faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we don't see.
4. Amplified Version – Faith is the assurance, confirmation, the title deed of things we hope for, being the proof of things we don't see and the conviction of their reality – faith perceiving as real facts – what is not revealed to the senses.

>> **IMPORTANCE OF FAITH:**

1. We are saved by grace through faith; Eph. 2: 8
2. We live by faith: Gal. 2: 20; Habak. 2: 4; Romans 1: 17; Gal. 3:11; Heb. 10:38
3. We please God by faith: Heb. 11: 6
4. Anything outside faith is sin. Romans 14: 23
5. We walk by faith (lifestyle): 2 Cor. 5: 7
6. We access God's power by faith: John 1: 12
7. We pray by faith: Mark 11: 24; Luke 18: 8; Mark 9: 22

>> **THE TWO IMPORTANT SIDES OF FAITH:**

Faith has two sides:

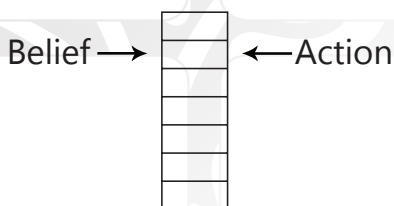
1. The belief side: this is when you believe that what God has said, He will do (Rom. 4: 16ff). You believe with your heart (Rom. 10: 10).
2. The action side: this is when you do something because of what you believe (Rom. 10: 10) you confess with your mouth. You take a corresponding action (James 2: 14ff).

Believing is accepting in your heart that what God has said is true.

Action is what you do outside the heart.

Faith without action is dead and cannot please God.

>> **How FAITH COMES: (THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT)**

- Faith has ONE SOURCE ONLY: Rom. 10: 17
- Faith comes in measures: Eph. 4:7; Rom. 12: 3
- Faith grows to maturity and unity: Eph. 4: 13
- Faith is released into the world through saying or speaking: Mark 11: 22 – 24 and 2 Cor. 4: 13

Faith must have additions to be fruitful: 2 Peter 1: 5, 9 – 10

>> **FAITH'S APPLICATION:**

1. Faith is applied after God has spoken: Rom. 4: 16 – 25; Matt. 8: 5 – 10; Luke 5: 1 – 9
2. Faith is applied and time does not count: 2 Kings 4: 15 – 16
3. Faith is applied with a corresponding action: John 5: 8 – 9
