## HOLY SPIRIT AND HIS ANOINTING



**> DEFINITION:** (According to A W Tozer)

### **The Holy Spirit:**

- We are surrounded by a material world right from childhood (milk, bed, mother, etc)
- Matter presses upon us so impressively and takes over our thinking so completely that we can't speak of spirit without using materialistic terms.
- Material things have characteristics like weight, dimensions, shapes, outlines, etc which can be measured, however small. This is one mode of existing.
- Matter simply bumps against matter, it cannot penetrate each other.
- The example of snow, water and vapour is wrong about the trinity.

### **>>WHAT HE IS:**

1. The Holy Spirit is a Being dwelling in another mode of existence. He has no weight, no measure, no size, no color, and no extension in space.
2. He is a person with qualities and powers of personality. He is not matter. He is substance. He is not wind or breath since these are non – personal and non – individual things.

3. He has will, intelligence, feeling, knowledge, sympathy and ability to love, see, think, hear, speak, desire and many other things which qualify a person.

### >> **WHO HE IS:**

- He is God: Matt. 28:18; John 4:24
- He is equal to the Father and the Son. 1John 5:7
- He is every where. Psalm 139:7 – 8
- He is eternal. Heb. 9:14
- He is indivisible with the Father and the Son.

### >> **HOW TO CULTIVATE HIS COMPANIONSHIP:**


1. He is a person He should be wooed in prayer: Amos 3:3; Luke 11:13
2. He comes to those who glorify Jesus: John 7:37
3. He comes to those who will just believe in Him: Acts 19:1ff

### >> **THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT:**

#### **(IN THE OLD TESTAMENT):**

- He was there in the creation of the world: Gen. 1:2
- He empowers God's servants and prophets: Judges 14:6
- There was no ruler in Israel sent by God without the Holy Spirit: 1 Sam. 16:10

#### **(IN THE NEW TESTAMENT):**

- 
- He comforts, teaches and abides with us for ever: John 14:16 – 18, 26
  - He replaces Jesus, reproves the un saved of sin, righteousness, and of judgment: John 16:7 – 12
  - He guides the church into all the truth and speaks the words of Jesus: John 16: 13 – 15
  - He empowers the church with power of the highest for ministry: Luke 24:49; John 20:21 – 23; Acts 1:8

## >> **THE ANOINTING OF GOD:**

### **Definition:**

- It is the power of God which comes upon someone for God's work. Luke 4:18
- It is like to rub or smear oil on someone. In this case, the Spirit of God is rubbed on us ('Mashiyach'- Heb. It means to rub on). This is the power that makes things to happen.
- It is the power that manifests miracles and wonders. It is not falling or screaming

## >> **THERE ARE TWO KINDS OF ANOINTING:**

- 1. The Anointing Upon:** Judges 13:24 – 25; 14:6, 19; 15:1; Luke 4:18, this is for work of God, given to His servants. Joel 2:28
- 2. The Anointing Within:** John 14:16 – 17; 1 John 2:27; 1Cor. 2:9ff; 2Cor.1:21; Eph. 1:19. It is for revealing to us the things of God, bringing revelation and understanding, guidance and comfort.

### >> **THE ANOINTING IS IN 3 LEVELS:**

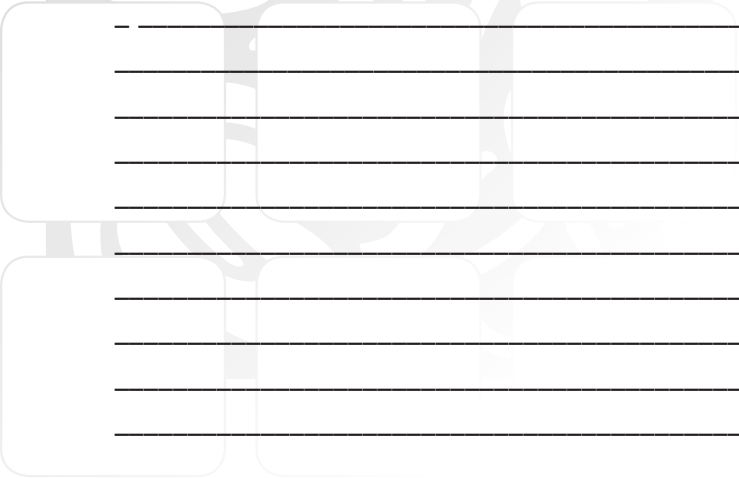
- 1. Well level:** John 4:14; Lev. 14:15-18; Ezek.47:1-3. It comes by accepting the Lord Jesus. All leprosy is washed away. This is the first encounter with the Holy Spirit.
- 2. River level:** John 7:37; John 20: 21. It is a priestly anointing and a loin level Ezek.47:4.
- 3. Rain level:** Acts 2:1-4; Joel 2:28. It is a kingly anointing. It is the swimming level Ezek. 47:5.

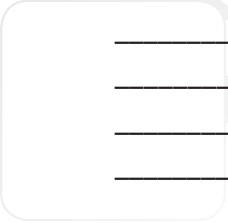
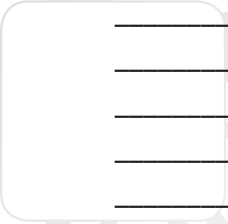
