> DEFINITION:

- Gaining what's aimed at, a prosperous progress.
- It is to know the purpose and will for your life.
- It is to know the path of life to your destiny.
- We are sojourners but not wanderers

Success is by principles not struggles: Eccl. 9: 11. Success principles transcend time and have the ability to transform lives.

>> THERE ARE TWO VISIONS IN A PERSON'S LIFE:

1. A divine vision: Jer 1: 4 – 5; Acts 26: 15
2. Your life vision :(it has to be in line with God's word) it is supported by your gifts and talents. John 4: 34

>> **THERE ARE TWO FORCES THAT ENHANCE SUCCESS:**

- **Relationships**

Your relationship with your God: Joshua 1: 7 – 8

Your interaction with people. Developing relational skills:
Luke 2; 52

- **Your achievements**

What you do today determines your tomorrow: Gal. 6:
7 – 9.

A life that is well planned and has priorities is a personal
achievement: Eph. 4: 1

>> **LOCATING SUCCESS:**

1. It begins with the mind. It is a good preferred end.
2. You should have mental pictures for tomorrow.
3. Your interaction and fellowship with people, the programmes on radio and TV which you give audience, and the church you go to.
4. The information you get. We are products of information.
5. Your orientation and how you take yourself as informed.
6. Your attitude determines your altitude.

>> **PURPOSE OF SUCCESS:**

- You were created to succeed: Gen. 1: 26 – 28, Psalm 35; 27
- Success brings joy: 1 Sam. 18: 6;
- Success gives influence: Gen. 23: 5; 39: 2 – 5.



>> 4 STAGES FOR SUCCESS:

- **Interaction:** the people you walk with, talk to, things and materials you read.
- **Information:** your interaction provides you with information. What we hear affects us.
- **Orientation:** it means alignment, affiliation, or sympathy. Directing your life as informed. This determines your placement and position.
- **Attitude:** the pattern of your thoughts begins to depend on the information you get.

>> 10 KEYS TO DISCOVER YOUR DESTINY:

1. The deepest desire of your heart: Ps. 37 :4
2. What stirs your passion or zeal? John 2: 13
3. What flows naturally out of you? 1 Sam. 16: 18
4. Where do you produce good fruit? Matt. 12: 33
5. What is the Holy Spirit witnessing to your spirit? Luke 2: 25
6. What are mature Christians seeing in you? 2 Tim. 1: 5
7. What career or ministry are you at peace in pursuing? Heb. 12: 14
8. What thoughts and dreams do you find impossible to remove from your head?
9. What can you give 100% of yourself to for the rest of your entire life?
10. What do people gather around you for? And what do they want to help you achieve?

>> **BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCCESS:**

1. Cautiousness – don't move any how
2. Creativity – you need to make witty inventions
3. Courage – don't listen to negative people

>> **BASIC ORDER OF PRIORITIES (PERSONAL PROGRAMMING):**

- **Faith** – the development and growth of your faith must be top priority
- **Fitness** – mental, spiritual and physical fitness should be cared for
- **Family** – a happy relationship with your family must be your target
- **Fellowship** – you should camp around people who build you
- **Finances** – create the right avenues for your income
- **Fun** – relaxing and fun should be part of your life

>> **FACTORS FOR GOD'S BLUE PRINT FOR SUCCESS:**

- **The Mouth factor:** teach yourself to talk God's word because your mouth steers your life. James 3: 2 – 5.
- **The Heart factor:** Meditation is so important. It enhances success. Ps. 1: 1 – 3.
- **The Doing factor:** you should be a doer of the word of God. James 1: 22



>> **SETTING GOALS IN LIFE: A KEY TO SUCCESS:**

- A goal is a set dream, a mental picture for achieving something. It inspires your future.
- A goal has to be specific, attainable, measurable, and with time limit.
- A goal can be adjusted or amended.
- A goal has to be processed
- A goal is tested with the Word and prayer
- A goal should not be exposed prematurely

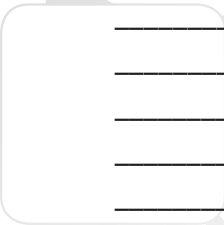
