NEW TESTAMENT FAITH ACTS

DEFINITION:

New Testament Faith Acts are referred to as works of faith. Things we do after believing what God has said in His Word. These acts are prompted by the Holy Spirit and they concur with God's word. These acts glorify Jesus.

1. THE ACTS OF ANOINTING OIL:

Definition: It is an instrument of extraordinary performance. It carries the power of the Spirit of God.

>>THE ANOINTING OIL IS BIBLICAL:

- Exodus 30:23ff it was used to make holy whatever it touched.
- **1 Sam. 16:13** when David was anointed, it was the Spirit of God that came upon him, not oil.
- **Mark 6:12-13** when Jesus sent his disciples, they anointed many and healed them.
- **James 5:14ff** the early church was instructed to use oil for all manner of sickness



>>THE MINISTRY OF ANOINTING OIL:

- It enthrones: Israel kings were anointed as they were enthroned. 1 Sam.10:1; 16:13
- It changes men's status. You get a tag of honour. 1 Sam. 10:1
- It brings favour: Saul was saluted and given gifts. 1 Sam. 10:4
- It turns you into another man: 1 Sam. 10:6
- It restores that which is lost: 1 Sam. 10:2
- It produces signs and wonders and ends all frustrations:
 1 Sam. 10:7
- It communicates the healing power of the Lord: Mark 6:13 and James 5:14
- It makes things holy: Exod. 30:26-27

N.B. All the above is by faith in the name of Jesus Christ.

2. THE ACT OF FEET-WASHING:

Every part of our body is significant to God. While hands are for laying on the sick to be healed, feet are for possessing possessions. Acts 4:37.

>> JESUS' EXAMPLE OF FEET WASHING: John 13:1ff

- Jesus had taught about humility elsewhere: Matt. 11:28 –
 29; 18:1 5; 23:11 12
- Jesus was about to be crucified. He was releasing the best He had for the ones He loved to the end.

- Peter's refusal to be washed prompted Jesus to threaten breaking fellowship with him. Peter thought that Jesus was washing their feet as a servant would do. No servant can make such threats.
- After his resurrection and ascension, the disciples received great gifts which were brought to their feet. Acts 4:33-37
- Jesus gave power to His disciples to trample on Satan under their feet. Luke 10:19

>> FEET IN PROPHECY:

- Our feet being placed and established: Psalm 31:8; Psalm 40:2
- Our feet gaining speed over our enemies: Gen. 49:21; Heb. 3:19
- Our feet carrying good news: Isa. 52:7; Eph. 6:15

3. THE ACTS OF THE MANTLE:

A mantle can be a garment or any article a man or woman of God had in contact in the hands of his or her servant. It is a point of contact with the anointing of God. The anointing of God is transferable

>> BIBLICAL EXAMPLES:

- The anointing on Elijah came upon Elisha: 2Kings 2:9-15
- Elisha's bones transferred life to a dead body: 2Kings 13:20-21
- The woman with an issue of blood simply touched Jesus' cloth by faith and she was healed: Mark 5:25; Matt.14:36

 The apostle Paul's hankies and garments healed the sick: Acts 19:11

4. THE ACTS OF HOLY COMMUNION:

This is eating and drinking the body and the blood of Jesus through the medium of bread and wine or other drink. Matt. 26:26; Mk. 14:22; Luk. 22:19; 1Cor.11:24

Jesus' body and blood are true food and drink. John 6:55

>> Understanding the body of Jesus:

- Through the body of Jesus we were reconciled to God: Eph.2:14ff; Col.1:21ff
- Through the body of Jesus the devil was destroyed: Heb.2:14; Col.2:14
- Through the body of Jesus all our sins and diseases were carried to the cross: Matt.8:17; 1Peter 2:24; Isa. 53:5

>> Understanding the blood of Jesus:

- The blood of Jesus carries the life of God: John 6:47ff
- The blood of Jesus washed all our sins and iniquities: Heb. 9:22ff
- The blood of Jesus purchased the church of Jesus: Acts 20:28
- The blood of Jesus sealed the New Testament: Matt. 26:26; Heb.8:6
- The blood of Jesus is the greatest weapon that overcomes the devil: Rev.12:11

5. BLOOD OF SPRINKLING:

- 1. It is a symbol of the spiritual sprinkling: 1Pet. 1:2. We are referred to as the elect of the Lord because of the sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ.
- 2. It is the blood of sprinkling that seals the New Testament which Jesus mediated. Heb. 9:19.
- 3. It is an act of faith which symbolizes God's covering over His children. Heb.11:28.
- 4. It is an act that provokes the blood of Jesus to speak better things into your life. Heb. 12:24-25
